Anisul, belongs to lower middle class family and who lost his Father during his Childhood. The boy was identified through referral program of AJMAL Mobilization team-“Seekho Aur Kamao”, Learn and Earn. After enrollment in **Seekho Aur Kamao-Learn & Earn**-A team of expert provided him the required knowledge & technicalities for Business Finance & Accounting Trade as **guided course curriculum** under NCVT.

Upon successful completing the training-he is well versed now to work in accounting and finance domain which includes using latest ERP version of accounting. He learnt the nitty gritty of working in almost all sectors for the Trade of Business Finance and Accounting through Seekho Aur Kamao “Learn and Earn” training program implemented by AJMAL Foundation sponsored by Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India.

He obtained indoor placement under payroll of AJMAL Group of companies soon after finishing the training program. Today, he manages the “Account” for Account receivable and Account Payable within AJMAL Group of Companies with salary of 17,400 INR currently working in Bombay.

As Anisul recalls “I was tensed. My father died during my childhood. I am just done with my graduation and needed immediate placement for support of the family. “**Seekho Aur Kamao**”-**Learn and Earn** instilled confidence in me. I am happy I am supporting the family”.

Managing her time with four year kid at home, she attended the training program under **“Seekho Aur Kamao”** implemented by AJMAL Foundation. She learnt both the domain she was glad getting practical exposure by her practical Class as well OJT to HAMM Hospital & Research Centre, one of its kinds to understand various instruments, techniques involves in grafting etc.

After successful completion of the training program in **“Seekho Aur Kamao”** Learn and Earn –She obtained her placement with above Rs. 5000 in MARYAM AJMAL Women college of Science and Technology (MAWST) where she is working as a Care Taker and also providing necessary first hand assistance for medical aid for Girl students in the college.

She provides the whole credit to AJMAL Foundation for providing such opportunity of training and placement through **“Seekho Aur Kamao”** Learn and Earn Scheme implemented AJMAL Foundation sponsored by Ministry of Ministry of Minority Affairs.

With burden of not getting suitable establishment and annoyed with burden of growing needs of family-he is finally left with utterly indiscreet of un-certainty of future. The referral program run by mobilization team counseled and shortly placed him for Training in Retail-Sales Batch. In times he used to approach the trainers in personal level to understand product identification and selling techniques in various geographical places. After successful completion of the Training program- He obtained a placement under HAMM Hospital & Research Centre with salary of Rs. 8000 who manages external vendor management as well data entry for patients in Hospitals
